



Kandinsky Circles

An artist called Kandinsky used shapes like circles, lines and squares in his paintings.

To paint like Kandinsky, do this:

- 1 Draw some squares on a paper using a pencil. I did 6 squares but you can do as many as you like.



- 2 Get your paints, paintbrush and some water.

Add more paint if you want the colour bolder or brighter and more water if you want it to be lighter and weaker.

Play around with the paint on another piece of paper to get the colour you want.

- 3 Paint each circle a different colour. Use the colours you like best.

Try this:

You can do this again and again - choosing different colours each time.

Use squares, hearts or other shapes to make a new painting.
